The purpose of our Summer Reading Program is to help our students keep their brains exercised and fight the learning loss that occurs when school is not in session. Studies have found that students who read at least four books over the summer can prevent the Summer Slide. Also, a student who reads 20 minutes per day will be exposed to 1.8 million words per year and can score in the 90th percentile on standardized tests! (Scholastic)

Spending some time reading to your child or with your child will not only make them smarter, but it will also help them complete their summer reading challenge too. Students who read or have books read to them, 1,250 pages or more, and complete their summer math, will enjoy a trip to Lake St. Clair Metro Park in Sept, including lunch, at no cost to you! Your child's list of pages read during the summer is due on the first Wed. of school.
